

DRIVING SAFETY COURSE (DSC) INFORMATION

YOU MAY BE ABLE TO REQUIRE THAT THIS CHARGE BE DISMISSED BY SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING A DRIVING SAFETY COURSE OR A MOTORCYCLE OPERATOR TRAINING COURSE. YOU WILL LOSE THAT RIGHT IF, ON OR BEFORE YOUR APPEARANCE DATE, YOU DO NOT PROVIDE THE COURT WITH NOTICE OF YOUR REQUEST TO TAKE THE COURSE.

You may be denied to take DSC if:

- You were speeding 25 mph over limit or 95 mph
- You were passing a school bus
- A hit and run offense (occupied vehicles)
- Had a serious traffic offense (involved in an accident)
- The offense occurred at a work zone (while workers are present)
- You have a commerical driver’s licence
- You have taken DSC in the past 12 months

You may request to take a driving safety course for dismissal in person or by mailing this affidavit signed and notarized to the Manor Municipal Court P.O. Box 589 Manor, Tx 78653. Once the court receives the notarized affidavit, you will be mailed specific instructions to provide the court with pertinent information within 10 business days and your course completion due date. Please contact the court if you have more than one violation in you citation.
